Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,140
Single restaurant server	\$27,154 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$566
Teacher and office clerk family	\$73,647 and \$50,725 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,134
Single nurse with overtime	\$108,360 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,876
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,314 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,350
Electrician family	One earner at \$100,782 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,722
Plumber family	One earner at \$102,828 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,777
Construction worker family	One earner at \$63,963 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,872
Police officer family	One earner at \$101,662 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,945

Firefighter family	One earner at \$46,072 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$2,663
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$66,951 and \$38,314 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,050
