Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,140
Single restaurant server	\$27,123 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$565
Teacher and office clerk family	\$73,534 and \$50,692 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,119
Single nurse with overtime	\$108,392 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,878
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,321 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,350
Electrician family	One earner at \$100,606 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,717
Plumber family	One earner at \$102,266 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,762
Construction worker family	One earner at \$63,907 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,870
Police officer family	One earner at \$101,352 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,937

Firefighter family	One earner at \$46,072 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$2,663
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$66,885 and \$38,321 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,049

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
