Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,140
Single restaurant server	\$28,424 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$603
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,945 and \$50,076 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,376
Single nurse with overtime	\$91,575 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,266
Single-parent home health aide	\$39,850 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,405
Electrician family	One earner at \$82,507 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,638
Plumber family	One earner at \$76,927 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,486
Construction worker family	One earner at \$55,045 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,900
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,455 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,809

Firefighter family	One earner at \$60,982 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,337
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,735 and \$39,850 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,951

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
