Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,706
Single restaurant server	\$28,563 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$642
Teacher and office clerk family	\$53,830 and \$42,765 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,891
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,545 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,817
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,414 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,946
Electrician family	One earner at \$75,197 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,955
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,807 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,700
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,063 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,267
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,355 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,547

Firefighter family	One earner at \$51,371 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,736
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,565 and \$31,414 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,411
