Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,706
Single restaurant server	\$30,600 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$866
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,346 and \$45,406 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,248
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,347 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,920
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,632 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,953
Electrician family	One earner at \$83,264 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,173
Plumber family	One earner at \$76,585 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,992
Construction worker family	One earner at \$67,119 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,736
Police officer family	One earner at \$75,716 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,160

Firefighter family	One earner at \$62,396 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,505
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,099 and \$31,632 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,732
