Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,706
Single restaurant server	\$30,616 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$867
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,425 and \$45,823 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,234
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,317 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,882
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,035 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,966
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,653 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,021
Plumber family	One earner at \$75,714 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,969
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,967 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,722
Police officer family	One earner at \$66,543 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,922

Firefighter family	One earner at \$61,330 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,482
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,420 and \$32,035 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,806
