Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,706
Single restaurant server	\$30,886 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$891
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,414 and \$46,134 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,776
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,441 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,923
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,641 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,953
Electrician family	One earner at \$80,267 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,092
Plumber family	One earner at \$76,788 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,998
Construction worker family	One earner at \$56,066 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,851
Police officer family	One earner at \$68,720 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,979

Firefighter family	One earner at \$62,379 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,504
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,527 and \$31,641 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,798
