Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,706
Single restaurant server	\$27,192 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$548
Teacher and office clerk family	\$52,146 and \$40,631 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,787
Single nurse with overtime	\$71,425 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,338
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,764 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,957
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,135 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,601
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,546 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,585
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,586 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,616
Police officer family	One earner at \$59,945 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,452

Firefighter family	One earner at \$45,701 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,346
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$54,929 and \$31,764 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,458
