Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,163
Single restaurant server	\$22,478 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$352
Teacher and office clerk family	\$52,732 and \$36,661 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,968
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,538 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,035
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,990 median local wage; 1 child	\$320
Electrician family	One earner at \$51,443 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,313
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,109 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,966
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,161 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,712
Police officer family	One earner at \$51,170 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,406
