Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$31,213 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$817
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,240 and \$42,193 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,532
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,950 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,429
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,248 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,702
Electrician family	One earner at \$58,102 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,958
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,886 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,033
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,719 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,296
Police officer family	One earner at \$69,739 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,610

Firefighter family	One earner at \$48,807 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,121
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,989 and \$33,248 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,089
