Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$26,144 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$509
Teacher and office clerk family	\$51,174 and \$40,841 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,219
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,015 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,247
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,133 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,615
Electrician family	One earner at \$56,058 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,694
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,853 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,027
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,521 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,164
Police officer family	One earner at \$58,041 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,065

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$41,797 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,429
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$47,896 and \$31,133 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,852

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
