Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$31,360 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$825
Teacher and office clerk family	\$59,109 and \$45,167 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,555
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,950 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,429
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,263 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,703
Electrician family	One earner at \$59,519 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,126
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,126 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,126
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,972 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,307
Police officer family	One earner at \$66,315 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,479

Firefighter family	One earner at \$44,072 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,980
