Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$29,508 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$692
Teacher and office clerk family	\$59,902 and \$42,658 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,508
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,640 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,418
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,141 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,656
Electrician family	One earner at \$58,477 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,991
Plumber family	One earner at \$56,862 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,876
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,122 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,271
Police officer family	One earner at \$66,470 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,515

Firefighter family	One earner at \$41,225 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$2,942
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$54,464 and \$32,141 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,071
