Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$23,518 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$398
Teacher and office clerk family	\$52,619 and \$41,377 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,274
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,752 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,127
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,039 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,611
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,355 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,613
Plumber family	One earner at \$52,088 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,519
Construction worker family	One earner at \$44,996 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,225
Police officer family	One earner at \$56,645 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,944

Firefighter family	One earner at \$39,251 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,229
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$50,957 and \$31,039 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,945
