Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$29,567 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$699
Teacher and office clerk family	\$56,457 and \$42,932 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,407
Single nurse with overtime	\$88,186 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,364
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,681 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,595
Electrician family	One earner at \$58,761 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,015
Plumber family	One earner at \$53,789 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,589
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,244 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,868
Police officer family	One earner at \$62,420 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,168

Firefighter family	One earner at \$45,852 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,027
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,330 and \$30,681 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,000
