Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$31,605 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$837
Teacher and office clerk family	\$54,920 and \$43,952 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,407
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,552 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,267
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,134 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,780
Electrician family	One earner at \$53,799 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,590
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,542 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,295
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,189 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,045
Police officer family	One earner at \$57,519 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,053

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$39,268 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,231
