Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$30,725 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$790
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,029 and \$43,454 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,561
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,855 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,426
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,866 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,686
Electrician family	One earner at \$59,130 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,072
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,875 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,031
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,888 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,303
Police officer family	One earner at \$69,135 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,593

Firefighter family	One earner at \$39,777 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,244
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$55,039 and \$32,866 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,107

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
