Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,567
Single restaurant server	\$30,678 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$788
Teacher and office clerk family	\$60,823 and \$43,375 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,553
Single nurse with overtime	\$89,699 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,420
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,830 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,685
Electrician family	One earner at \$59,065 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,060
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,816 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,020
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,843 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,302
Police officer family	One earner at \$68,812 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,584

Firefighter family	One earner at \$39,692 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$3,273
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$55,050 and \$32,830 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,106
