Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,299
Single restaurant server	\$31,181 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$783
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,994 and \$51,827 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,944
Single nurse with overtime	\$82,945 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,032
Single-parent home health aide	\$41,441 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,026
Electrician family	One earner at \$69,760 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,113
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,421 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,020
Construction worker family	One earner at \$51,234 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,217
Police officer family	One earner at \$80,051 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,773

Firefighter family	One earner at \$56,872 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,732
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,500 and \$41,441 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,602
