Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,066
Single restaurant server	\$37,190 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,219
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,596 and \$41,250 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,650
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,870 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,314
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,053 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,746
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,224 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,755
Plumber family	One earner at \$84,905 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,663
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,767 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,944
Police officer family	One earner at \$85,213 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,871

Firefighter family	One earner at \$65,457 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,760
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,398 and \$37,053 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,233
