Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,066
Single restaurant server	\$36,424 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,159
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,283 and \$40,864 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,631
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,542 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,265
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,087 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,748
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,205 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,734
Plumber family	One earner at \$79,837 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,525
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,884 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,051
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,464 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,824

Firefighter family	One earner at \$65,272 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,705
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,156 and \$37,087 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,200
