Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,073
Single restaurant server	\$41,621 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,480
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,552 and \$51,414 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,127
Single nurse with overtime	\$102,626 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,608
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,801 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,549
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,701 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,214
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,743 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,215
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,820 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,038
Police officer family	One earner at \$71,668 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,522

Firefighter family	One earner at \$60,444 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,535
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,129 and \$38,801 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,399
