Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,073
Single restaurant server	\$39,512 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,317
Teacher and office clerk family	\$90,561 and \$52,416 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$10,592
Single nurse with overtime	\$104,878 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,517
Single-parent home health aide	\$41,783 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,687
Electrician family	One earner at \$83,258 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,706
Plumber family	One earner at \$84,634 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,745
Construction worker family	One earner at \$63,019 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,139
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,653 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,890

Firefighter family	One earner at \$74,706 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,607
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,188 and \$41,783 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,540
