Single restaurant server	\$25,616 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$542
Teacher and office clerk family	\$67,203 and \$49,007 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,764
Single nurse with overtime	\$109,756 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,286
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,299 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,542
Electrician family	One earner at \$67,813 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,084
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,421 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,073
Construction worker family	One earner at \$54,552 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,768
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,852 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,759

Firefighter family	One earner at \$71,552 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,388
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$66,268 and \$35,299 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,584
