Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,122
Single restaurant server	\$27,101 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$615
Teacher and office clerk family	\$66,545 and \$44,441 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,456
Single nurse with overtime	\$107,936 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$6,217
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,054 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,361
Electrician family	One earner at \$68,838 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,113
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,211 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,956
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,952 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,645
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,379 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,718

Firefighter family	One earner at \$64,155 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,963
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,893 and \$31,054 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,013
