Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,209
Single restaurant server	\$50,559 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$2,189
Teacher and office clerk family	\$82,377 and \$44,245 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,899
Single nurse with overtime	\$101,389 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,609
Single-parent home health aide	\$39,318 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,714
Electrician family	One earner at \$78,548 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,488
Plumber family	One earner at \$79,456 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,513
Construction worker family	One earner at \$54,014 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,107
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,081 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,784

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$77,518 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,660
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$61,542 and \$39,318 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,294

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
