Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,209
Single restaurant server	\$50,990 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$2,209
Teacher and office clerk family	\$82,862 and \$46,411 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,330
Single nurse with overtime	\$98,005 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,486
Single-parent home health aide	\$39,406 median local wage; 1 child	\$3,719
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,179 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,451
Plumber family	One earner at \$86,940 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,716
Construction worker family	One earner at \$53,587 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,090
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,012 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,782

Firefighter family	One earner at \$77,508 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,660
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$63,528 and \$39,406 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,387
