Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,209
Single restaurant server	\$49,511 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$2,063
Teacher and office clerk family	\$82,200 and \$46,643 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$7,234
Single nurse with overtime	\$100,971 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,594
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,765 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,676
Electrician family	One earner at \$83,114 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,612
Plumber family	One earner at \$77,738 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,466
Construction worker family	One earner at \$51,908 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,025
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,929 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,862

Firefighter family	One earner at \$77,058 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,648
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,721 and \$37,765 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,229
