Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,209
Single restaurant server	\$48,648 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$2,006
Teacher and office clerk family	\$72,963 and \$43,919 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,861
Single nurse with overtime	\$99,047 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,524
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,149 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,691
Electrician family	One earner at \$79,673 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,519
Plumber family	One earner at \$71,423 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,282
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,609 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,052
Police officer family	One earner at \$91,320 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,035

Firefighter family	One earner at \$87,806 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,940
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,998 and \$38,149 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,247
