Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$38,187 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,217
Teacher and office clerk family	\$74,433 and \$45,818 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,938
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,114 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,869
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,506 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,433
Electrician family	One earner at \$67,365 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,873
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,273 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,843
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,611 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,992
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,662 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,467

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,030 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,612
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,557 and \$32,506 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,810
