Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$38,521 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,234
Teacher and office clerk family	\$69,344 and \$46,260 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$4,995
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,890 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,898
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,391 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,471
Electrician family	One earner at \$66,033 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,837
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,195 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,841
Construction worker family	One earner at \$53,712 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,036
Police officer family	One earner at \$90,888 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,721

Firefighter family	One earner at \$61,581 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,580
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,725 and \$33,391 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,867

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
