Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$39,365 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,298
Teacher and office clerk family	\$78,468 and \$47,607 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,772
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,274 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,912
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,026 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,456
Electrician family	One earner at \$66,964 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,862
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,185 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,868
Construction worker family	One earner at \$59,201 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,612
Police officer family	One earner at \$104,664 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,101

Firefighter family	One earner at \$74,182 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,261
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$63,742 and \$33,026 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,885
