Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$37,885 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,202
Teacher and office clerk family	\$77,411 and \$46,703 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,457
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,716 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,891
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,852 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,448
Electrician family	One earner at \$70,079 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,948
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,718 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,855
Construction worker family	One earner at \$59,336 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,644
Police officer family	One earner at \$86,221 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,593

Firefighter family	One earner at \$66,127 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,943
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,586 and \$32,852 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,793
