Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$36,579 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,050
Teacher and office clerk family	\$71,364 and \$41,009 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,858
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,153 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,685
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,133 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,375
Electrician family	One earner at \$73,209 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,034
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,294 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,761
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,154 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,260
Police officer family	One earner at \$62,724 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,605

Firefighter family	One earner at \$47,155 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,422
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$54,506 and \$31,133 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,578

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
