Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$37,848 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,200
Teacher and office clerk family	\$77,848 and \$46,782 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,564
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,877 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,897
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,877 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,449
Electrician family	One earner at \$69,559 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,934
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,580 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,852
Construction worker family	One earner at \$59,850 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,666
Police officer family	One earner at \$86,622 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,604

Firefighter family	One earner at \$66,199 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,964
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,507 and \$32,877 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,792
