Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$38,463 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,231
Teacher and office clerk family	\$65,974 and \$46,039 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,850
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,678 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,890
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,903 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,493
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,769 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,829
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,130 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,839
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,251 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,978
Police officer family	One earner at \$85,190 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,564

Firefighter family	One earner at \$57,397 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,487
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,517 and \$33,903 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,875
