Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$38,563 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,236
Teacher and office clerk family	\$79,196 and \$45,908 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,616
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,791 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,857
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,700 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,484
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,019 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,809
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,379 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,818
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,245 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,977
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,453 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,461

Firefighter family	One earner at \$60,142 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,180
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,475 and \$33,700 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,786
