Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$39,459 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,305
Teacher and office clerk family	\$78,872 and \$47,895 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,898
Single nurse with overtime	\$87,460 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,919
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,078 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,458
Electrician family	One earner at \$66,941 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,862
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,407 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,874
Construction worker family	One earner at \$59,479 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,656
Police officer family	One earner at \$105,944 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$6,136

Firefighter family	One earner at \$75,282 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,291
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$63,984 and \$33,078 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,893

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
