Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$38,034 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,209
Teacher and office clerk family	\$81,779 and \$45,118 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,912
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,630 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,851
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,479 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,432
Electrician family	One earner at \$80,831 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,244
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,911 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,778
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,166 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,974
Police officer family	One earner at \$78,480 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,379

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$62,768 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,606
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$60,386 and \$32,479 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,777

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
