Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$5,491
Single restaurant server	\$37,791 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,197
Teacher and office clerk family	\$77,751 and \$46,291 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,449
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,455 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,882
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,753 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,444
Electrician family	One earner at \$69,896 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,943
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,198 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,841
Construction worker family	One earner at \$58,369 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,474
Police officer family	One earner at \$84,182 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,536

Firefighter family	One earner at \$64,923 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,676
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,095 and \$32,753 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,777
