Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,098
Single restaurant server	\$21,081 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$198
Teacher and office clerk family	\$51,133 and \$38,706 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,252
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,018 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,114
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,129 median local wage; 1 child	\$1,776
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,645 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,277
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,123 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,993
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,416 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,691
Police officer family	One earner at \$60,794 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,773

Firefighter family	One earner at \$50,100 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,163
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$55,028 and \$28,129 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,070
