Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,098
Single restaurant server	\$21,876 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$235
Teacher and office clerk family	\$56,429 and \$40,096 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,378
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,709 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,140
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,893 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,316
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,503 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,273
Plumber family	One earner at \$61,842 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,228
Construction worker family	One earner at \$45,330 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,811
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,499 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,308

Firefighter family	One earner at \$49,474 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,139
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,096 and \$28,893 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,229
