Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,098
Single restaurant server	\$21,369 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$211
Teacher and office clerk family	\$52,455 and \$39,697 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,316
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,568 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,098
Single-parent home health aide	\$28,781 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,285
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,989 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,286
Plumber family	One earner at \$59,810 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,172
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,073 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,718
Police officer family	One earner at \$77,274 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,909

Firefighter family	One earner at \$60,044 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,204
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$55,881 and \$28,781 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,111
