Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$3,807
Single restaurant server	\$33,594 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$836
Teacher and office clerk family	\$71,724 and \$50,226 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$4,843
Single nurse with overtime	\$122,454 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$8,254
Single-parent home health aide	\$42,091 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,731
Electrician family	One earner at \$85,579 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,464
Plumber family	One earner at \$82,524 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,389
Construction worker family	One earner at \$51,774 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,850
Police officer family	One earner at \$93,674 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,757

Firefighter family	One earner at \$79,779 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,417
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,599 and \$42,091 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,870
