Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$3,807
Single restaurant server	\$38,219 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,036
Teacher and office clerk family	\$88,235 and \$53,237 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,385
Single nurse with overtime	\$135,641 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$8,179
Single-parent home health aide	\$46,973 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,813
Electrician family	One earner at \$108,180 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,176
Plumber family	One earner at \$106,103 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,101
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,307 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,144
Police officer family	One earner at \$102,881 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,805

Firefighter family	One earner at \$90,406 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,677
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$67,301 and \$46,973 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$4,491
