Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$3,807
Single restaurant server	\$32,557 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$790
Teacher and office clerk family	\$77,194 and \$48,367 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,450
Single nurse with overtime	\$113,441 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$7,931
Single-parent home health aide	\$42,023 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,731
Electrician family	One earner at \$89,841 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,442
Plumber family	One earner at \$95,696 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,539
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,646 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,817
Police officer family	One earner at \$96,181 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,577

Firefighter family	One earner at \$80,135 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,426
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,936 and \$42,023 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,844
