Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$3,807
Single restaurant server	\$37,932 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,023
Teacher and office clerk family	\$86,940 and \$52,919 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$9,309
Single nurse with overtime	\$135,576 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$8,176
Single-parent home health aide	\$46,657 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,806
Electrician family	One earner at \$106,929 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,131
Plumber family	One earner at \$104,979 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,873
Construction worker family	One earner at \$56,916 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$3,115
Police officer family	One earner at \$102,012 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,774

Firefighter family	One earner at \$88,096 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,621
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$67,134 and \$46,657 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$4,536
