Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$3,807
Single restaurant server	\$37,858 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$1,020
Teacher and office clerk family	\$85,937 and \$52,449 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$8,724
Single nurse with overtime	\$135,670 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$8,180
Single-parent home health aide	\$46,063 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,794
Electrician family	One earner at \$105,972 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$5,096
Plumber family	One earner at \$104,037 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,839
Construction worker family	One earner at \$56,419 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$2,991
Police officer family	One earner at \$99,989 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,701

Firefighter family	One earner at \$86,040 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,570
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$66,708 and \$46,063 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,720
