Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,071
Single restaurant server	\$30,513 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$681
Teacher and office clerk family	\$78,834 and \$43,073 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,019
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,326 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$4,911
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,619 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,342
Electrician family	One earner at \$69,304 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,201
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,157 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,032
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,216 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,798
Police officer family	One earner at \$78,504 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,654

Firefighter family	One earner at \$59,119 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,868
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,819 and \$30,619 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,983
