Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$4,071
Single restaurant server	\$30,390 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$672
Teacher and office clerk family	\$80,276 and \$44,840 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$6,520
Single nurse with overtime	\$93,992 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$5,195
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,804 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,355
Electrician family	One earner at \$67,740 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,158
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,184 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,060
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,441 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$4,812
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,203 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$5,784

Firefighter family	One earner at \$61,609 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$4,926
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,394 and \$30,804 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$5,976
